Student tastes different culture

Attitudes towards drinking definitely differ in Denmark, according to Salt Spring Island student Nick Hock, who recently returned from a Rotary exchange trip to that country.

Memorable to Hock were high school dances where teachers sold beer to students, and students and parents got drunk together.

"Sometimes, teachers get as drunk as the students," said Hock, who lived in Denmark for the past year and attended dances such as those described above.

"I must say I thought they were pretty fun."

He said the Danes are not alcoholics and youths don't go running through the streets drinking, but "it was so different for me that it is one thing that stands out.

"I want to stress they are not all alcoholics."

Hock, 18, said Danes are much more liberal than Canadians. Teenagers are often allowed to drink at home and boyfriends or girlfriends are often allowed to sleep over.

Many parents believe that if their children are going to get drunk, the first time should be at home in their presence.

Parents say "we know they are going to do it so . . .," said Hock. Youths "knew they could drink whenever they wanted so it was no big deal."

He said youths in Denmark are more mature and have more responsibility.

"There is a lot more trust between parents and kids."

Hock arrived in Denmark July 17, 1991. For the first two weeks he attended a language course to ac-

Useful, artistic creations

They look like inspiring objets d'art, but Karen Marie says her woven baskets' should serve a purpose first.

Marie specializes in making functional ribbed "gathering baskets," mainly from island honeysuckle and grape vines with imported rattan materials.

Her baskets are meant for toting on arms and use in gathering and transporting the needs of daily lives.

"The whole intent of a basket is for it to be used," says Marie.

"I would like to see people using them in place of paper bags at stores. And I can go away for a weekend and pack everything I need in one basket."

Marie's basket weaving studio at 1060 Walker's Hook Road is one possible stop on a Sunday "open studio" tour initiated on Salt Spring this summer.

Marie became "hooked" on basket making three years ago after taking a workshop on the subject with Cynthia Minden of Pender Island. It was a craft that came easily to her and is now something she hopes someday to do fulltime.

She describes the experience as "repetitious, contemplative and calming."

Part of the fun is in gathering honeysuckle vines or other materials for use in making baskets, she says. Friends and children Dylan and Chris join her to make a meaningful outing where they incidentally "rescue" trees being strangled by the vines.

"It's definitely a family project," says Marie. Chris and Dylan often bring home materials they would like their mom to weave. Dylan made and sold his own basket at ArtCraft one year.

While sizes and shapes of bas-

kets rely somewhat on the basic nature of the vines used for the basket opening, handle and ribbing, Marie has ample control of the end product.

"They can be very free-form artistic pieces or the process can be manipulated so I can get the desired shape." Marie insists her baskets are in the "craft" category as functional pieces rather than being "art" which exists primarily to be

viewed.

"Mine are craft but baskets have opened themselves to being art. Baskets can have an artistic value."

She sells at ArtCraft, from her studio and to friends and acquaintances, and has a hard time keeping

an excess of baskets on hand. A large basket can take an entire day to make.

Basket making is "among the oldest and universal crafts of man" having no specific area of origin. They have been made and used all

over the world for centuries and command respect in most cultures.

All baskets are made by hand. Participation in the open studio tour organized by the Chamber of Commerce accommodations group has worked well for Marie.

"People see basket making on it and they want to come around. People do find me and they do come in, so the studio tour is a good idea."

Many island artisans have opened their studios and workshops to visitors from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Sundays. Maps and information on the studios are available from the Ganges tourist information centre..

quaint himself with the Danish tongue. He attended school — located 30 kilometres south of Copenhagen — with other exchange students.

"We learned quickly young people can drink beer."

Although most Danish people speak English well (most also know German or French) Hock tried to avoid speaking English and to learn Danish. He learned the language "pretty well," understood Danish on television, and could converse in it.

"Physics class I did not understand. When they are talking about protons it is pretty hard."

He said he was behind in physics, math, and some other classes but was ahead of Danish students in French. "That is their third language."

Hock said he was able to teach them some things, and gave presentations and slide shows to many classes on Canada. In rural areas, some students asked Hock for his autograph because he was Canadian.

Liberal ideas also extend to the classroom. Not only did students smoke in the school, but if students did not attend classes nor do their homework, teachers did not care. Students just fell behind.

"Students were more serious and didn't really mess around like some people do in our system."

Hock said if he had attended school in Denmark since he was young "I think I would have learned more."

European students are also more aware politically, he said. When voting on whether or not to join the European Community, "information was everywhere. Students knew what they were voting about."

The voting age in Denmark is 18, and important national matters have to be voted by referendum, said Hock.

By the time Hock returned to Canada, he found himself becoming more politically aware, also.

Environmentally, Canadians are more aware, he said. There are no virgin forests left in Denmark, and he missed Canada's wilderness "and the fact you could go places and see no-one."

He also missed his car, using a bike for transportation in Denmark.

"It wasn't as good as a car but I stayed in shape."

Bicycle lanes were everywhere, Hock added.

He also toured other European areas, such as Prague, Berlin, Vienna, Italy, and St. Petersburg in Russia.

His travels through Europe heightened his interest in World War Two history. In and around St. Petersburg, formerly Leningrad, he saw bullet holes in buildings, and foxholes and bomb craters.

"The Germans were right there."

Now at home on Salt Spring, he said he would like to return to Denmark and see his friends but there is the problem of money. "It is ex-


Ergo, the Silly Season.

Now if you'll excuse me, I'm off to buy a mickey of Grand Mariner and a very small mink stole.




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


MARG SIMONS

Former Galiano resident dies

A service was held in Nanaimo recently in memory of former Galiano resident Jack Kolosoff.

Several years ago Kolosoff moved from his home at Spotlight Cove to Chemainus where he was to enjoy the amenities of town during his declining years.

The Kolosoff family moved to Spotlight Cove in North Galiano before the First World War. Jack and his brother Bill and his two sisters, Olga and Elsie, were among the students enrolled at the North Galiano School when it opened in 1916.

The family left the island shortly after the war, but still held the property with Jack's uncle remaining here until his house burned to the ground in the mid-1930s.

In 1942 Jack and his wife Dorothy returned to the cove with their four children, all of whom attended the North Galiano School. The younger ones, still attending at the time of the school's closing, later enrolled at the present school in south Galiano.

Kolosoff worked as a logger and a fisherman during his many years as an island resident.



You're that Moe fellow

My spies in Ottawa tell me that Moe Sihota is one of the most recognized faces in the capital these days. Walking along Sparks Street last week, Moe was stopped on several occasions by passers-by who said things like, "you're that constitutional guy from B.C. . . . Moe, Moe . . ."

Small wonder, actually, considering the exposure Sihota has been getting on national TV as British Columbia's constitutional affairs minister. Way to go, Moe.

More about Moe

Meanwhile, on the home front, wearing his labour minister hat, Sihota is getting more than a little impatient with the ongoing pulp and paper workers strike.

Last week Sihota warned the two parties that it was getting increasingly difficult to allow them to cripple British Columbia's economy. Talk like that usually leads up to government intervention, not a pretty prospect for an NDP government which considers trade unions its natural allies.

There's gold in them there hills

New data showing considerable concentration of gold, copper, lead and more than 30 other metals in a little-explored area of south-central British Columbia was released last week.

The survey area, stretching from the North Thompson River to Mount Waddington, has not been explored using modern techniques, Mines Minister Anne Edwards said.

"Prospectors will be enthusiastic over the results for gold and copper, and there will be new mineral exploration and claimsteking," the minister predicted.

More than 125,000 samples were tested during the survey. The samples came from 2,500 stream locations in an area covering more than 45,000 square kilometers. High concentrations of metals in the water samples are clues to where these metals may be found in the ground.

The results pinpoint more than 38 sites with gold concentrations greater than 100 parts per billion, and tree sites greater than 500 parts per billion.

Consumer alert

If you get a notice in the mail, saying you've been selected to receive a cash award or valuable merchandise, phone your nearest Consumer Operations Branch, listed in the blue pages of your telephone book under L for Labour and Consumer Services.

Whatever else you do, don't send money to claim your prize, because the scheme is a scam. The Ministry of Labour and Consumer Services issued a press release last week, explaining how the scam works and promising to put a stop to it.

Typically, the notification comes from B.C.-based Noram Direct Marketing Ltd., using names like Home Discount Service, National Claim Service, International Warehouse Centre, Award Processing Centre and Phone-4-Cash.


The con scheme leads consumers to believe that they have been "selected" to receive cash or some other item of substantial value. To claim their award, consumers are asked to send money up front, up to \$79.08.
