## Information-packed tour promised at eco-home event

The Salt Spring Island Conservancy and the Earth Festival Society will run their second Eco-Home Tour from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Sunday, August 6.

Following the success of last year's event, organizers promise an information-packed day of guided tours to 10 unique ecological and sustainable homes on Salt Spring.

With a reputation for environmental awareness, creativity and concern about sustainability, many islanders have developed innovative housing solutions and Salt Spring has an abundance of eco-friendly homes to fuel the tour.

"Many of Salt Spring's residents moved here for the natural beauty and eclectic community," notes a press release. "In recent years, many residents concerned about sustainability have put their ideas into action by building homes that reflect their values."

Islanders and visitors can view sustainable home technologies such as windmill power, rammed earth, hemp straw bale, cob, water-catchment, masonry heating, solar and grey water systems.

Tour participants will hear about these technologies from the homeowners themselves, many of whom built their own homes. The tour features an organic farm with solar water heating, a masonry heater with built-in bake oven and plumbing for hot water, I-WOOD construction that uses 30 per cent less lumber and less waste, the island's first legally permitted cob dwelling, which has walls made from sand, clay and straw, and insulation made from recycled blue jeans, and a hemp straw bale home.

Other technologies include an energy retrofit of a 1950s cottage with a solar hot water system and several water catchment systems.

"The homes are packed with ideas to reduce energy and water usage and associated operating costs," state tour organizers.

Tour maps and tickets can be picked up at Salt Spring Books in Ganges, Morningside Organic Bakery and Cafe in Fulford, and the Salt Spring Island Conservancy office, Suite #201 in Upper Ganges Centre. Tickets cost \$25 each or two for \$45. Same-day tickets may be available, but advance purchase is recommended.

Organizers highly encourage carpooling and cycling, and several homes are clustered together for ease of access.

"You may wish to form carpools with neighbours and friends," suggest organizers. "You can also meet at Gulf Islands Secondary School to park your car and form carpools at 9:30 a.m. This year volunteers will assist people to link at individual houses wherever possible. All proceeds go to support the operations of the Conservancy to educate schoolchildren, the public, and landholders about land and water stewardship."

The tour will be launched with a Sustainable Building Forum on August 5, featuring architect Helen Goodland, executive director of B.C.'s Sustainable Building Centre. The event takes place at Meaden Hall at 120 Blain Road, with exhibits open at 6:30 p.m. and the program at 7.

## Radio show back on stage

After last year's sold-out performance, islanders will once again have the rare opportunity to enjoy radio dramas from the 1940s and '50s as Jan Rabson stages his second Radio Theatre presentation at ArtSpring.

Complete with music, live sound effects and live commercials, the August 18-19 event will feature the talents of Rabson and other Gulf Islands actors, including Arthur Black, Yvonne Adalian and Vaughn Fulford.

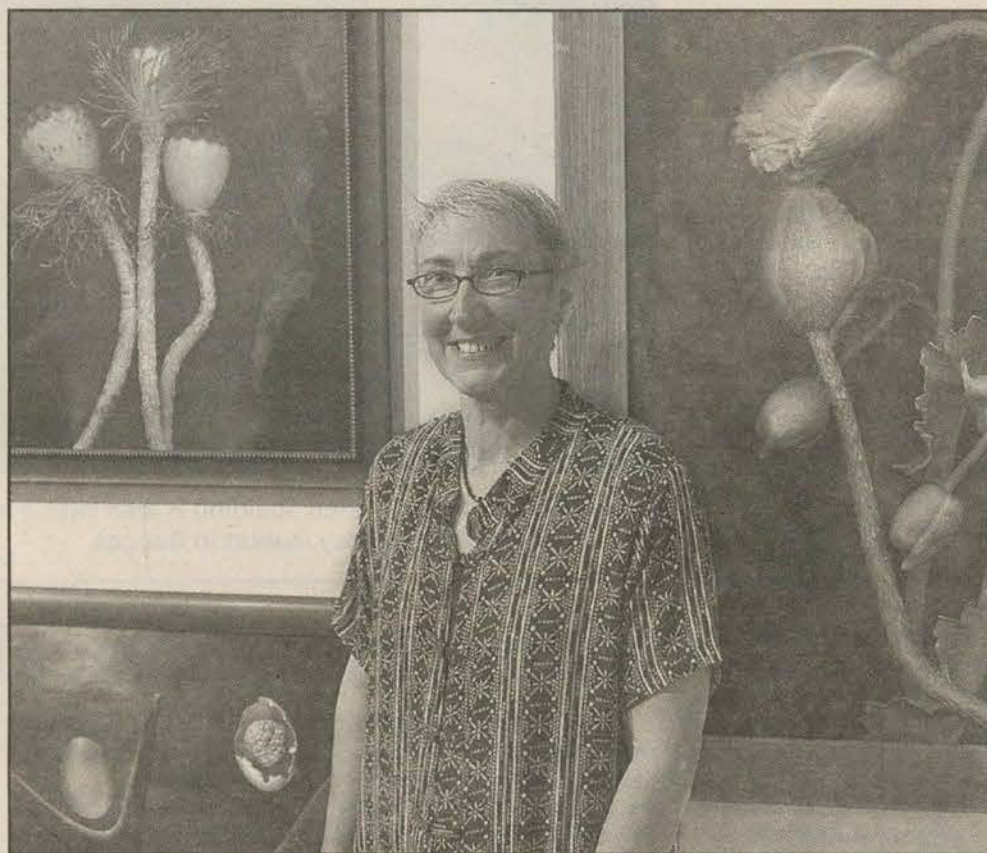
"If you were lucky and were in a major city in the 1930s, '40s or '50s you might have attended a live radio drama production," describes a press release. "Performers on stage acting out the parts of detectives, murderers, femme fatales and vixens. Sound effects of men slamming doors, dropping bodies and launching rockets. It was a rare opportunity to witness a world of imagination coming to life."

Rabson and cast will wear period costumes to re-create three 30-minute shows, including a suspense show, a journey to Mars in 1986, and a sci-fi futuristic comedy. They will be interspersed with authentic live radio commercials and a "Five Minute Mystery" from the era.

"In a show business career that has spanned five decades, Rabson has performed in everything from The Tonight Show to — most recently — Cars and Ice Age II," notes the press release. "His resume boasts literally thousands and thousands of credits."

This full-scale production is geared for all ages and takes place at ArtSpring at 7:30 p.m. on August 18 and 19. Tickets are \$18 for adults and \$14 for students.

The event is sponsored in part by Oystercatcher and Moby's restaurants, Li Read, Flader and Hale, Windsor Plywood and Ganges Floor Coverings.

## Local film premieres at international festival

A film shot on the shores of Salt Spring last winter has been chosen for the Rhode Island International Film Festival (RIIFF).

The film, titled Shipwrecked, was shot entirely on location at Beddis Beach over three months. It was selected from over 2,000 entries and will premiere at RIIFF.

The 10-minute film follows a lonely boy, played by Salt Springer McKenzie Bolton, as he discovers a mini shipwreck and dozens of tiny footprints on the shores of a desolate beach.

The film was directed by McKenzie's father Devon Bolton, a former Salt Spring resident now based out of Calgary, and produced by Devon's sister Kirsten Bolton. Devon and Kirsten are the children of long-time Salt Springers Bev and Terry Bolton.

In a press release, Devon describes the film's message as "imagination is salvation... [It's] a poetic film that seeks to capture the wonder, mystery and potential of a child's imagination to see the world in a creative way."

The tale takes place in one afternoon, but what was originally expected to be a five-day shoot turned into a three-month ordeal due to intermittent weather and tidal fluctuations.

"For continuity, we had to wait for the tide and the cloudy weather to be similar each day... We got sun, snow, winds, pouring rain, everything but the cloudy grey weather we wanted. When we did, it virtually never matched up with the tides," said Devon.

Huge logs and an "unmovable dock" which washed onshore also slowed down the filming process, as did the chopping down of an "historic" tree by vandals. "Luckily our earlier filming captured what might be the last images of that tree, so now it's preserved," said Devon.

RIIFF is an Oscar-qualifying festival now in its 10th season. In 2003, the festival was named one of the top 10 short film festivals in the United States. Shipwrecked has also been entered into festivals in Chicago, Hollywood, London and Australia.

A six-minute version of the film will debut on Bravo later this fall.

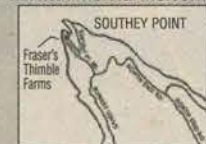

## Jazz group soars with joy into orbit

Experiencing fine jazz musicians is like taking a vacation from the everyday—without the huge expense and trouble of figuring out what to pack.

On Friday night, bassist Neil Swainson, pianist/drummer Misha Piatigorsky and guitarist Pat Coleman offered just such an escape at ArtSpring.

A native of Victoria, Swainson moved beyond the island settling first in Vancou-

ver, then Toronto and playing with many jazz greats. Composing has also figured prominently in his life.

Piatigorsky grew up in Moscow listening to his father compose music for the Taganka Theatre. Starting piano at age five, immigrating to the United States when he was eight and discovering jazz at 16, led to a B.A. from Rutgers University and a Masters from the Manhattan School of Music. In 2004 he won the prestigious BMI Thelonious Monk Composer's Competition.

Coleman presently resides in Nanaimo and is considered one of Canada's finest jazz guitar players. Because of his talent and years put into his instrument, his guitar is like an extension of his body with less intellectual decision and more intuitive taste.

Jazz standards were the order of the evening, opening with a blistering *East of the Sun (and West of the Moon)*. Having heard both Swainson and Coleman before in various venues on the West Coast, I expected a high calibre of musicianship. The revelation was Piatigorsky's piano playing. While staying within the confines of the form, he played with dynamic splendour and pushed his colleagues into orbit.

Chick Corea's *Windows* came second, featuring an evocative bass solo that allowed the audience to journey on the melody.

The other favourite of the first set was one of Antonio Carlos Jobim's compositions, which began with a melodic line that established the piano as a rhythm instrument. A gorgeous soulful few notes repeated in the bass and guitar shared the job of grounding the piece in rhythm.

In the second set, everyone relaxed into the groove and really started to listen to each other, making for a

very enjoyable set.

Coleman's playing in the ballad *Detour Ahead*, made famous by an array of musicians from Billie Holiday to Herb Ellis, was truly soulful.

Piatigorsky stood in as drummer in about half of the pieces in the evening. With his rhythmic expertise on the piano, that didn't seem unreasonable. The qualities that made him such a superb pianist—being able to play outside the prescribed melody in inventive ways and his energy, became troublesome.

A jazz drummer, any drummer for that matter, needs to be first and foremost in the pocket and holding down the fort rhythmically. Fills are great, but they can't take over the main function.

Used to being a skillful soloist, his drumming was distracting from especially Coleman's playing. Coleman, solid as a rock, had to be the one that kept the rhythm going. I'd have rather heard his solos fly.

In Cannonball Adderley's *Wabash*, Piatigorsky's drum playing was finally subtle and tasty, allowing the other two to just lay back and play.

The evening was part of the Sizzling Summer Nights festival, which continues with the Cottars on Friday night and Simona Colonna Trio on Saturday.
