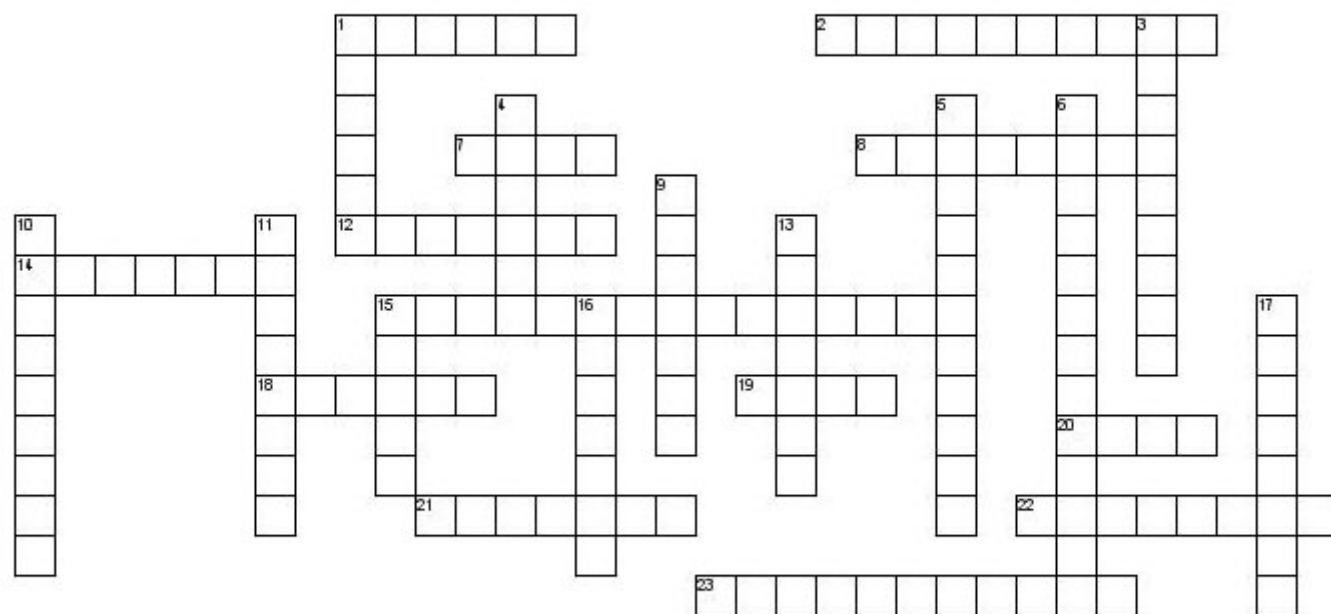


# Kanaka: Salt Spring's Hawaiian Community
